

First Meeting with Life Scout – 45 minutes

Eagle Leadership Project Concepts

Suggested guidelines for the Troop Committee to consider in order to “level the field” for Eagle Candidates.

- Develop a comprehensive outline for the project. Including a “time line” listing subject matter time spent and contact identity. A materials list with cost and method of procurement is required.
- The project should have significant societal and financial impact.
- The project should benefit a not for profit organization and be of community service in nature.
- Develop an agreement statement outlining what is to be done with a projected time line (contract) between the project beneficiary and yourself. Execute this agreement and provide a copy to both parties, this will help to reduce delays and misunderstandings regarding the plan and its execution.
- The project should have a minimum retail value of \$2-4k. This valuation would include labor and materials.
- A fund procurement plan should be developed and executed prior to project initiation.
- Photographic documentation prior to during and after the project is completed.
- Site plan.
- Construction details.
- Work schedule.

- Leadership issues including procurement notification care of and safety issues.
- Copies of your “Thank You” letters.
- Identification and approval pages in project workbook (spiral notebook with printed downloaded pages) completed: pages 1, 6 and 9 to the District Advancement Committee Representative sign off block.
- Route sheet completed thru step 1, items 1 and 2
