Specific Duties:

4. Serve as Patrol Quartermaster for securing supplies from QM.
5. Help develop and maintain patrol spirit.
6. Work with other troop leaders to make the troop run well.
7. Set a good example.
8. Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly.
9. Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
10. Meet Active Scout Requirement.
 - a. Attend the Troop Leadership Training (TLT) session at the beginning of the term.
