Job Description: The Chaplain Aide, with the assistance of the Troop Chaplain ASM, works to meet the religious needs of Scouts in the troop and leads Troop community service outings.

Specific Duties:

1. Keep troop leaders apprised of religious holidays when planning activities.
2. Assist chaplain or religious coordinator in meeting the religious needs of troop members while on activities.
3. Prepare and lead service at every campout, if not attending arrange replacement in advance.
4. Encourage saying grace at meals while camping or on activities.
5. Tell troop members about religious emblem program of their faith.
6. Set a good example.
7. Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly.
8. Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
9. Meet Active Scout Requirement.
10. Attend the Troop Leadership Training (TLT)
11. Lead **all** Troop service projects.
12. Lead troop in Scout prayer at events
13. Along with the Assistant Quartermaster, maintain and inform troop members of uniform exchange program.
14. Work with Chaplain ASM, Chartered Organization Representative.
 1. Work with charter organization to involve troop in Scout Sunday and other church functions
