Job Description: The Order of the Arrow Troop Representatives is a youth liaison serving between the local Order of the Arrow lodge or chapter and his troop.

Specific Duties:

1. Serve as a communication link between the lodge or chapter and the troop.
2. Assist with leadership skills training in the troop.
3. Encourage Arrowmen to assume leadership positions in the troop.
4. Encourage Arrowmen in the troop to be active participants in lodge and or chapter activities and to seal their membership in the Order by becoming Brotherhood members.
5. Coordinate OA elections at the Troop.
6. Coordinate travel and attendance for recently elected OA candidates to an Ordeal.
7. Coordinate travel and attendance for Ordeal members to become Brotherhood members.
8. Work with the adult OA representative (ASM-Order of Arrow Advisor) to encourage troop participation in OA events.
9. Set a good example.
10. Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly.
11. Live by the Scout Oath, Scout Law, and OA Obligation.
12. Show and help develop Scout spirit.
13. Meet Active Scout Requirement.
 - a. Attend the Troop Leadership Training (TLT)
