Job Description: The Patrol Leader is the elected leader of his patrol. He represents his patrol on the patrol leaders' council. The Patrol Leader is responsible for leading the patrol through their Patrol Activities. In this role, the scout is responsible for communication with all scouts for troop activities. The Patrol Leader also leads the patrol in their assigned Troop Meeting presentations.

Specific Duties:

1. Plan and lead patrol meetings and activities.
2. Keep patrol members informed.
3. Assign each patrol member a job and help them succeed.
4. Represent the patrol at all patrol leader council meetings and at the annual program planning conference.
5. Prepare the patrol to take part in all troop activities.
6. Develop patrol spirit.
7. Work with other troop leaders to make the troop run well.
8. Set a good example.
9. Enthusiastically wear the Scout uniform correctly.
10. Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
11. Meet Active Scout Requirement.
 - a. Attend the Troop Leadership Training (TLT) session at the beginning of the term.
12. Under guidance of SPL and ASM plan a Troop Meeting based on monthly theme.
13. Lead patrol in presenting Troop Meeting as requested by SPL at least once in 6 months.
